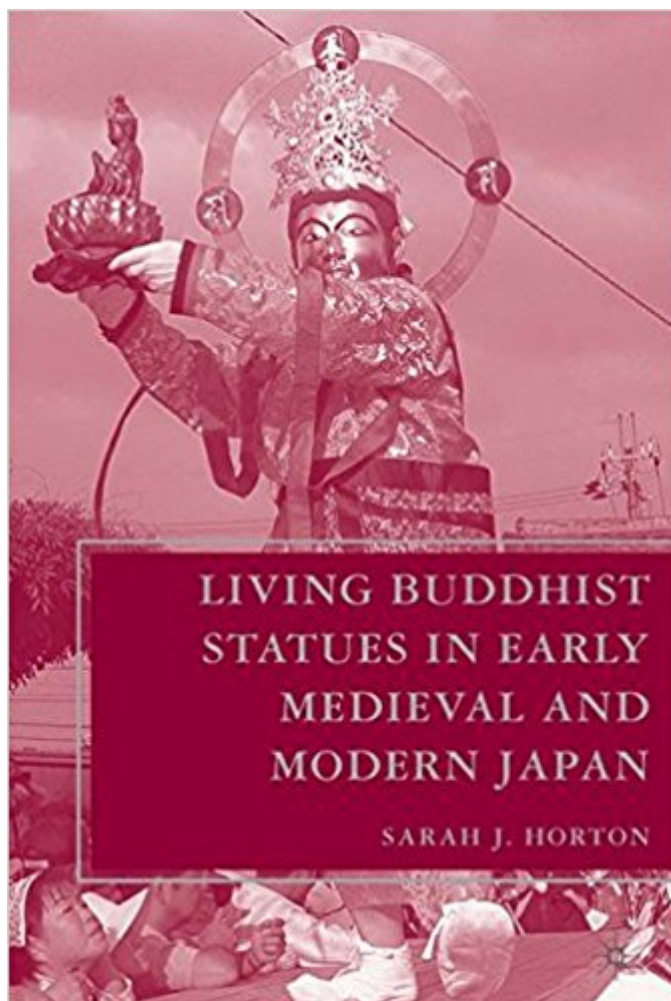

What a fine volume this is, located as it is at the nexus of documentary scholarship and field research. Living Buddhist Statues in Early Medieval and Modern Japan functions on many levels, but it excels both as a tutorial to the major Buddhist deities (Sakyamuni, Amida, Kannon, and Jizo) and as an exploration into how their Buddhist statues were -- and continue to be -- inextricably

linked with the lives of Japanese. The book is intelligently written, without a trace of wearying "acadamese". I did find myself wishing there were a few more photos of the temples and statues mentioned in the text, and as a resident of Japan I thought the book might have been more useful to include an appendix listing the major secret Buddhas and how often they are revealed, but these are mere quibbles. Ms. Horton's book makes a worthwhile introduction to Japanese Buddhism for the first-time learner, and it is equally a valuable adjunct of knowledge for those well-versed in the religion.
