

When I got there and opened it, I found lowest-common-denominator reviews in glowing prose of the more expensive Denver restaurants. I didn't feel I could trust any of them, and in fact got no benefit from the book at all. I left it in my hotel, for a future, less discriminating reader.

Indispensable for anyone living in Colorado, traveling to Colorado, or traveling through Colorado. Vivid, literate and fun descriptions of the food scene.

This book is based on 15 years' experience writing about food: My friend Ruth Tobias has lived in the Denver area for five years and before that was a food writer in Boston. In this book she provides a thorough guide to the Denver dining scene, covering everything from the lack of really good Thai food to cheese shops to green chile to food trucks to the proliferation of bars featuring "mixologists" to the restaurants where Beat writers used to hang out. I love her writing--here's a sample from the review of Steve's Snappin Dogs on Colfax: "Crayon colors and corrugated tin, picnic tables and peppy service: this City Park hot dog stand brings the mid-century drive-ins of the Eastern Seaboard--touchingly depicted in the old black-and-white photos that cover its walls--back to life. In

many ways, it's tried and true: gregarious Connecticut transplant Steve Ballas serves up first and foremost the pork-and-beef franks he grew up with, including his personal favorite, the Jersey Dog with bacon and caraway-touched sauerkraut."
