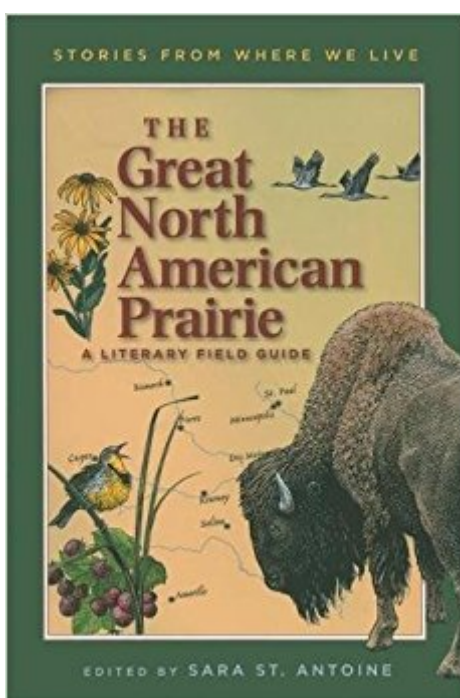

Gr. 4-8. This companion to *Stories from Where We Live: The North Atlantic Coast* (2000) includes stories, poems, journal entries, and essays that reflect life on the prairies of the U.S and Canada. The selections, both historical and contemporary, comprise a good mix of fiction and information, and reflect the ethnic diversity of the inhabitants. *St. Antoine* showcases familiar authors such as Carl Sandburg, Willa Cather, and Louise Erdich, as well as lesser-known writers. Also valuable are the generous appendixes, which include maps of the region, a detailed discussion of various kinds of prairies, listings of flora and fauna, an index sorted by state or province, listings of parks and preserves, and bibliographies. Occasional line drawings break up the longer selections. A solid addition to classroom units that will yield some good read-alouds during long drives through the heartland.
