

For some reason, this brand-new book at \$120 from comes keyless, even though the exact same book at your college bookstore contains one. So, there's absolutely no reason to buy one here, unless you get it used at a great price. Very, very disappointing, and just another example of college textbook publishers and book sellers ripping the public off, but at least you can learn from my mistake.

This is an excellent introductory Spanish textbook. I have used several introductory texts and this is definitely a superior book. The format is innovative and immerses the student in the Spanish language. I found the chapters to be a lively read and a great way to learn the language. Each

chapter has a vocabulary and grammar section which should be read and studied before reading the chapter. I have not used the online resources because I just purchased the book. One cautionary note, the book and the accompanying workbooks and online features are quite expensive. I was able to purchase a "new" book from one of the sellers and it is in excellent condition. I recommend this book for independent learning and as an adjunct to a text used in a beginning Spanish class.
