

I really like this for the most part but I have a few problems with it. Of course this isn't the full Bible so it skips stories but the problem that I had is that sometimes it would come in in the middle of a story. For instance when it gets to Noah and the flood it completely skips where God tells Noah to build the arc so you have to go back and explain to your child who Noah is and that he built a big boat. It just goes right into God making it flood and Noah and his family and the animals entering the arc. It also breaks the stories up into several discussions which I did not like. It would have a very small section of a story and then go into activities and easy discussion for the kids and also easy prayers to guide them through which is nice I just feel like the stories that they pick should have been full stories and not them jumping into stories in the middle of the story or breaking a story up the way it does.

I wasn't quite aware that it was happening, but in the past year or so I've collected several little kid Bibles. A few from book reviews, and one or two as gifts to my girls. This one is by far my favorite. The biggest difference between this one and the others is that the text is the New Living Translation of the Bible. It is select passages, all stories that will appeal to kids, but it is actual Biblical text. Other versions are good, but that are all re-written down to a preschoolers level. After reading through this version, though, I think most preschoolers would understand the stories straight from this version of the Bible. In the intro parents are instructed to help kids understand some of the bigger words, but it is easy enough to do that. In every passage, there are several hands-on activities to do with your kids as you read them the story. They are usually simple motions, such as covering your eyes with your hands to imagine what the earth was like before God formed it, or carrying a doll or stuffed animal as you read about how Moses' mother cared for him before placing him in the basket in the river. At the end of each passage, there is a prayer that makes the point of the Scripture personal. There are also two activities that are more than the simple ones in the story, and can help reinforce the message of the story. And finally, each passage ends with a "Jesus Connection," that helps your child see that Jesus is the center of all Scripture, even in the passages that don't mention him. This Bible is amazing, because it truly is the Bible. I'm not usually creative enough to come up with ways to help apply it to the life of a preschooler, and now I have an excellent tool. Tyndale House Publishers provided me with a free copy of this book as a part of their blogger book review program.

My two and a half year old daughter loves this book! I love being able to share the Bible with her. There are fun activities at the end of every lesson, ideas to incorporate though the week, a prayer, and a couple of discussion questions. There are also mini hands on activities throughout.We previously had "The Adventure Bible for Toddlers". This was excellent when she was under 2. We found it no longer went into enough detail for her, and she always had questions."My First Hands-on Bible" uses real scripture rather than summarized stories that older toddlers and preschoolers can still understand. My daughter asks me to read it to her every day now, and we will be getting copies for friends with preschoolers.

The stories are far too abbreviated to be of real teaching value. Surprisingly, there's little or no story-to-story continuity, and many of major events and themes are missing (e.g., in God's promise to Abraham). Get the The Jesus Storybook Bible instead.

My husband and I wanted a bible that was appropriate for our 3 and 5 year old, but it was also important to us that it contained actual scripture. This bible is perfect. It is broken down into stories, in the same order as the bible, and the text is scripture. The awesome part is that during the reading every once in a while you will see a little colored hand print which indicates a "hands on" activity. In the margin the activity is printed and is something simple like turning the lights on and off to go along with the Creation story when God says "let there be light". It keeps the children engaged and having fun with the story, but the activity is simple enough that it doesn't distract them from sitting down and listening. They quite easily stay focused on the story and are excited to see what happens next. At the end of the story is a an activity you can do during the week to review the story/concept of the story. There is also a prayer and I think some questions/discussion type stuff. I definitely recommend this bible!
