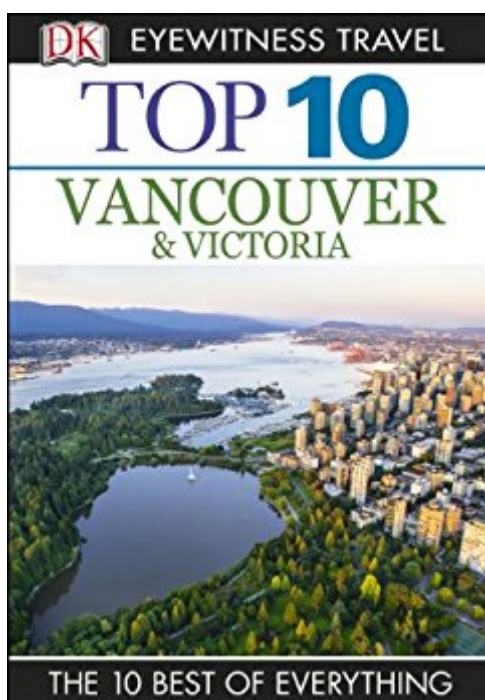

Typical DK format--easy to follow. Well summarized. So, can't criticize the information contained or its presentation--very good. But the book is overpriced for content--I didn't see a lot of things that I wanted to do that would make it worth buying. Mostly typical big city things like museums. We only had a day in Vancouver and it was raining very hard, so maybe that contributed to the lack of

usefulness of the book to me. I guess, bottom line, I didn't think Vancouver had enough to do to deserve its own book--better to just read a chapter on it in a travel book that covers a wider area.

This book didn't help much on details. Stanley Park for instance, closed their kids petting zoo/farm years ago. The big Indian district is not a big deal anymore according to the locals. Also the transit information could be a lot clearer. Must have exact change (and NOT bills) on bus. I know it's a digest, but after a day in Vancouver, pretty much abandoned this as a reliable resource. The maps were convenient.

Used this handy pocket guide on our trip to Canada. Saw a copy at our local library and decided that had to have my own copy. It came in handy during the planning stages and during our trip. Happy trails!

I purchased this before a July 2012 vacation to Vancouver, encouraged by the good DK Eyewitness guides to European cities (which I've used and swear by). This guide for Vancouver claims it was updated for 2012, but there is a lot of dated and completely incorrect information on hours, restaurants (some of which listed apparently closed or changed policies long before the revision date and those changes are not reflected), and attractions. While this may be useful for the obvious highlights, I would not recommend it for the details.
