

There are explanations for why we do what we do, what it means, the origins of the traditions, and even some recipies for the Sabbath dinner! It is a wonderful addition to your collection of Jewish books. The authors guide the reader through the Shabbat experience, including suggestions for family time, personal, time, etc. I especially love the CD that comes with this book.
