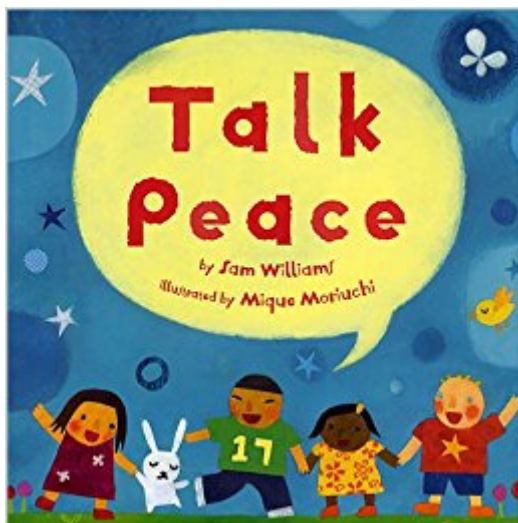

PreSchool-Grade 1 [Customer Review](#) --Saddened by events in the news, Williams pours out lyrics to express his feelings on peace. "On the street,/when you meet,/when you eat,/talk peace." This is a difficult concept to convey to a young audience, and the writing is unremarkable. Even the attractive illustrations, which are colorful and primitive in appearance, do little to enhance the abstract message. On the other hand, the circular tops of the trees and the rounded bodies on bears give some mellowness to the vague idea. The large-print, red text uses words that most first graders will recognize. However, with the spate of books on peace lately, including Vladimir Radunsky's *What Does Peace Feel Like?* (S & S, 2004) and Todd Parr's *The Peace Book* (Little, Brown, 2004), libraries probably don't need this one.
