

Executive Ben Fielding hits upon a perfect plan: he will make his company millions of dollars by using Chinese labor to manufacture its electronic components. To kickstart his plan, he visits China, where he stays with college roommate Li Quan, whom he hasn't seen in over 20 years. From Li, Ben learns that his initial impressions of China from his research and from visits over the years are false, but Ben doesn't believe Li's stories of the persecution of Christians until Li is taken to jail. As Ben rediscovers Jesus through Li's faith, he discovers the truth that God does not promise an easy life on Earth, only eternal happiness after death. Part of this novel appeared as a short story in The Storytellers' Collection (LJ 9/1/00); here, its strength is magnified tenfold. So many times Christian books and Christians can be so disappointing, But as I listened to Mr. Alcorn speak I knew he was "for real". His books, though fiction, are true to the word of God. Oh that I could be so real ... He makes me want to "real", to be like his Li Quan. If you read this book, you will never forget Li Quan. You will never forget this book, and you will always remember the author who could put such words, such thoughts, such lives on paper. You will long to read his books again as I have reread so many of his books ... but this is the best. It was a privilege to hear Mr Alcorn speak and a privilege to be able to read "Safely Home" again.

If you are a believer then this book is life changing...it is a "fictional" account of the persecuted church in China and gives a glimpse of the scriptural view of our eternity in Christ and the non-importance of our temporal lives here in the "shadow-lands." The last few chapters I needed a tissue to catch the trail of tears that coursed down my face...the awe and beauty of service to God, and the reality of the shortness of life in the here and now. This book is a gentle reminder as to what really matters in the life of a Christian believer and what our focus should be in this very fallen world.. This is a beautiful and haunting view of God's perspective on suffering and is an encouraging reminder that suffering will not be forever. I bought extra for gifts and believe I will be back for more....not a quick read, but an important one.

I really enjoyed the story line of this book and that the incidents in the story are based on real life events though maybe not all having happened to one person. The turn around of the character Ben was wonderful to watch unfold. It was a real eye opener to see the shroud covering the true merciless and inhumane persecution of Christians in China and in the 21st Century!!!
