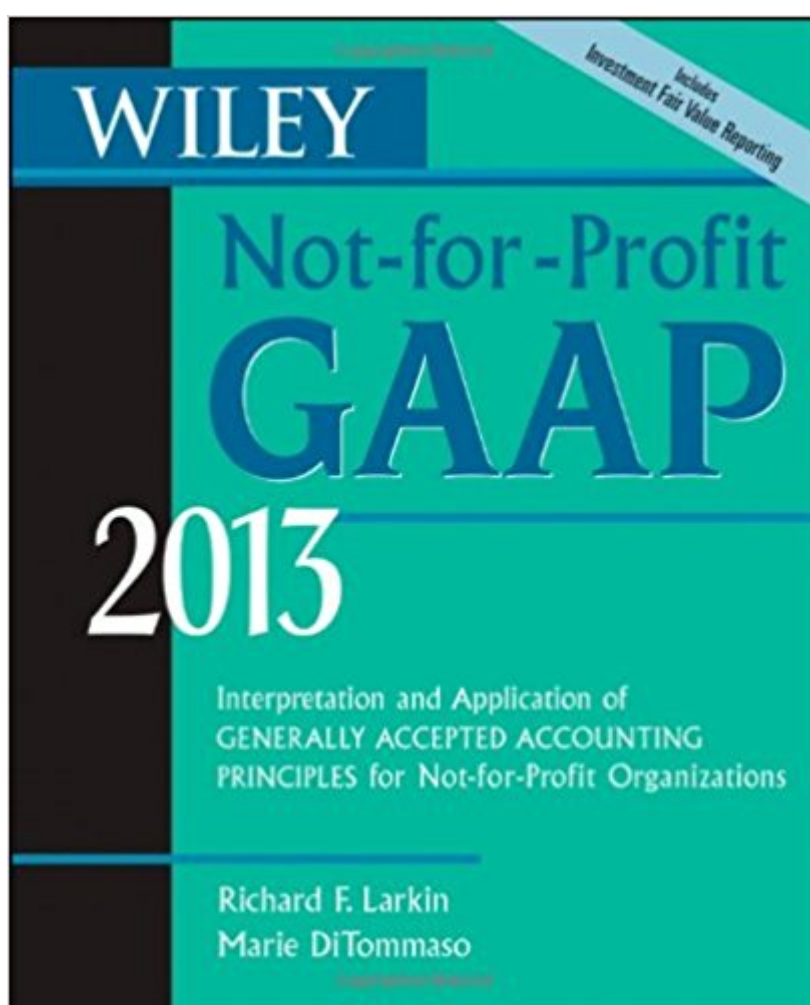

I am especially pleased with the index which gets you where you need to go as well as the content which is up-to-date and very clear. By comparison, I rate this book way ahead of the Wiley Financial and Accounting Guide for Not-for-Profit Organizations (8th ed) which is way more expensive but also way less user-friendly, far less succinct, not usefully indexed, and (for my purposes at least) often ambiguous just when I have felt I needed clear guidance. In my judgment, this is a sound, useful guide for people needing a practical reference on NFP accounting.
