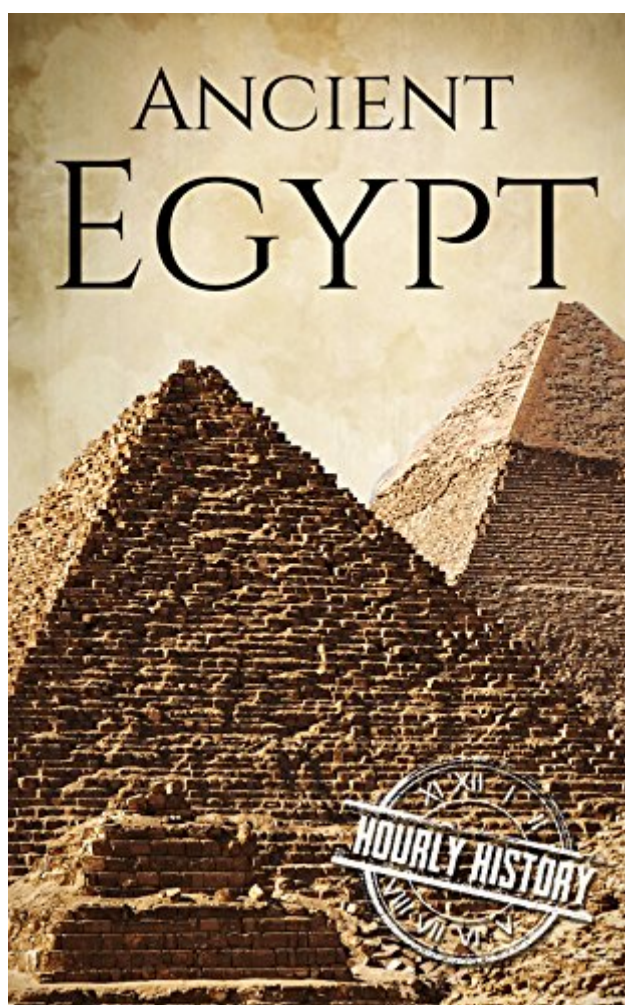

This is one of the best Hourly History books I have read. As usual, the promise is to give you a quick overview of the subject, one you can complete in an hour. "Ancient Egypt" begins with the Nile, explaining how the great river provided rich farmland for the early Egyptians, as well as papyrus reeds to use to record important details. The book moves on and covers religion, rulers, the pyramids, and also spends time explaining how mummies were prepared. Normally, the Introductions in Hourly History books are nothing more than information we will read again later in the book. This is one book that doesn't do that, and actually furnishes additional knowledge. Anyone who has completed a few books on Egypt will probably find little new in this book. However, for anyone who has not explored the wonders of this ancient civilization, this would be an excellent book to start with. It offers information on different facets of life, and one can then choose an avenue of study and move forward. Good basic read. Five stars.

I had a hard time deciding how many stars, because I felt based on reading prior books on ancient Egypt that this book was very brief. I will give it 3.5 stars because it did get most of the highlights. I like best the discussion about hieroglyphics.
