

VINCENT LEONARD, along with Thomas E. Randolph, is the coauthor of Recording in the Digital World, Finale: An Easy Guide to Music Notation, and Sibelius: A Comprehensive Guide to Music Notation. His worlds as a producer and composer have premiered nationally and internationally, and he is also widely known as a copyist and arranger, having worked with Peter Nero, the Philly Pops

Orchestra, Doc Severinsen, the London Symphony Orchestra, Chuck Mangione, and Leslie Burrs and in musicals by Duke Ellington, Alan Menken, Kurt Weill, and Mitch Leigh. He lives in Philadelphia.

This is another excellent text by Rudolph/Leonard. As with their other publications, this text is very well organized and clearly written. The video examples that are on the companion website and DVD are also excellent. I love the QR links so you can scan them with your iPad's camera and it takes your right to the video demo on YouTube. This would be a great text for a college or professional development course or for anyone interested in using their iPad for musical purposes. I would especially recommend this text for educators.

Helpful guide to teaching music using the iPad.

Given that the title includes the words, "Quick Pro Guide", I expected a lot more in the way of instruction on how to actually create, learn, and perform music using an iPad, in contrast to what this book does, which simply provides an overview of the main apps in each category. While a number of videos are included, again, they simply provide a very basic overview of how the app under discussion functions. You can get the same level of instruction by using each app's help function. Very disappointing...

The Musical iPad is a great purchase. I am a technologically savvy-girl, interested in music, and I have an iPad but had no idea what was possible. This was a great book to learn not only what is available and out there for those of us interested in music but also gave you the information you need to to learn much more than the basics. With a ton of QR codes that link to interactive videos from the authors, you get so much more than just a normal book! I really appreciated that the authors gave options for apps that ranged in price and simply explained the benefits to each one in comparison to the other. The authors do spend time explaining the basics (which I appreciated) but if you already know how each bit works, just skip the paragraph! There's stuff in this book for everyone. I would recommend this book to anyone who is looking to start to learn about music on the iPad or has a background and interest in iPad music and wants to expand their expertise. It's easy to understand and clear.

This book was VERY user friendly for people with all different technological levels. After I read it, I

gave the book to my father to read (self taught musician) with his first iPad and he loves it! It is not only helping him as a musician but also a first time apple device user. The QR codes/Youtube clips are excellent for visual and auditory learners. It is an excellent book and I've recommended it already to many musicians, music educators, and music majors to purchase!
