

I never realized that Paris had so many fascinating playgrounds and parks, and we certainly weren't able to try them all but the book pointed us in the right direction for terrific memories. Also,

If you thought that this book is to be read by children under age 12 or older - forget it! You would get that idea from the cover picture, wouldn't you. I've been looking for a picture tour book of Paris for my 7 year old grand daughter who is looking forward to a trip to Paris next year. Nonetheless, it is quite a sufficient book for adults to use on behalf of their children. For instance, through it I was introduced to France Miniature (look it up), of which I had been previously unaware. I think I'll give it to her father for his birthday.

Sorry, Fodor's, but you missed the mark on this. All text, no pictures... for kids... they can read the big guide book just as easy as this. If you are looking for a kid friendly guide, checkout the Mission Paris, Mission London, etc... now, that is a kid guide book!
