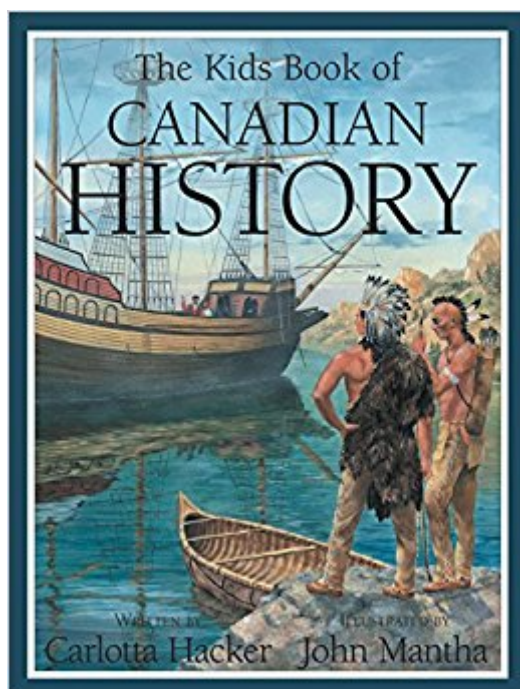

They include The Book of Canadians which was awarded the Children's Book Centre Choice, and The Kids Book of Canadian History. She also edits, under her married name Carlotta Lemieux, and was Consulting and Contributing Editor of the The Junior Encyclopedia of

Canada. John Mantha is an artist and illustrator. His books include *The Kids Book of Canadian Firsts* and *The Kids Book of Canada's Railway*. He lives in Toronto, Ontario.

This introduction to Canadian history will be interesting to adults as well as older children. The illustrations are high quality, and add to the reader's understanding of the historical periods covered in the book. Although the book, or at least the edition I read, was written several years ago, it gave me a good background for understanding present-day Canada. It doesn't go into much detail about First Nations people, but that might inspire you to read *The Kids Book of Aboriginal Peoples of Canada*. These books are so well written, I'm interested to see if there are more in this series.

I am giving you my review of these three books on Canadian History for Kids together because I bought them for my grandson who lives in the U.S. but also has dual citizenship and gets really good marks in American History. My grandson tells me that the books are great and he is really enjoying them - they are his 'go to bed books'. A great investment in American/Canadian relations

Great start to introducing Canadian history to my 5-year old. Illustrations are excellent and break down of topics are brief with just the right amount of depth. We just don't know enough about our history. Best to keep an easily accessible source at home for the kids to look over and discuss when the occasion rises.
