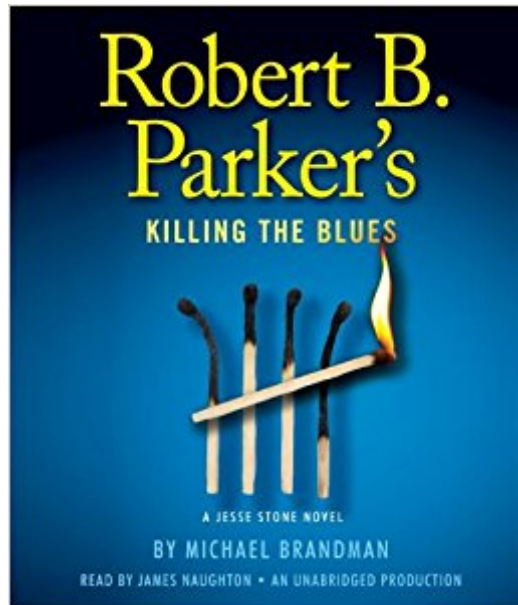

Michael Brandman is an award-winning producer of more than thirty motion pictures; he collaborated with Robert B. Parker on more than a dozen of them, giving him the ability to carry on the "Jesse Stone" series. They wrote the screenplay for TNT's Monte Walsh together, and Brandman has produced and written films for A&E and CBS. Brandman lives in California.

I love Robert B. Parker's Jesse Stone. I really didn't get interested in the book until I saw Tom Selleck on TV portraying Jesse. I started buying the books and reading them. I started with *Night Passage* and have continued from there. Keep them coming.

I don't know how he did it, but Michael Brandman has written a book that maintains the familiar surroundings and characters of Jesse Stone's town of Paradise, tells a face-paced, riveting story, and gives us more of our beloved hero, Jesse Stone - all in a way that I would have sworn was written by Robert B. Parker. I have already ordered his next book.

While I'm a BIG fan of Parker's Jesse Stone character, and this novel did not disappoint -it DID have more the feel of a transcript from a TV movie than an actual Robert B. Parker novel. And, while I realize we'll never again have an actual Parker novel, I do think this author could have done a better job of fleshing out the characters and surroundings (which Parker was SO good at). Otherwise, I was pleased, though perhaps just a bit underwhelmed.

Loved all the different story lines and that the people of Paradise didn't necessarily know what was going on. Also loved Jessie's new pet, quite a change for a big strong guy.

Always a good read, never disappointing. Anyone who loves Robert B. Parker will love this one too! I highly recommend it.
