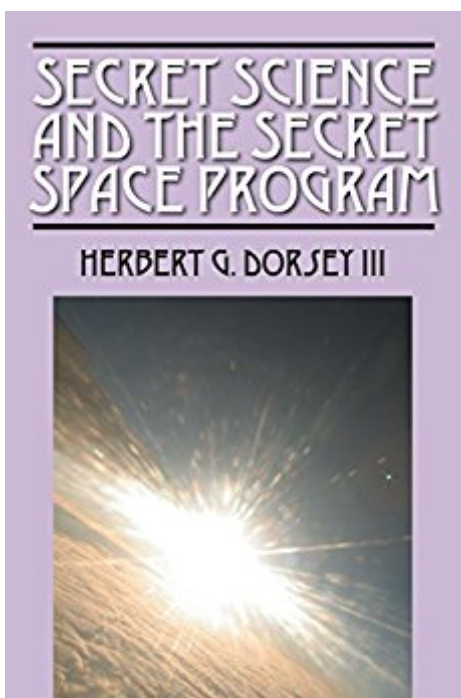

This is an exceptional book for several reasons:1. The first two chapters tell much of the history of suppressed inventions that reportedly produced more power and energy than expected, and tell of

the very credible attempts by powerful people to suppress these inventions for financial reasons. Many of them are supported by patent numbers, adding excellent credibility.² Although a scientist not exposed to anomalistic data (such as might be available in meetings about UFOs) might have difficulty even thinking about such things as time travel or Nazi flying saucers, those who are familiar with these topics will recognize the discussion as both logical and helpful. This reviewer thought they contained excellent information consistent with current whistleblower reports.³ The discussion and description of the various space fleets and their relations to covert reverse-engineered alien UFO technology is quite illuminating if historically accurate. The use of time travel “jump gates” to go to Mars will surely stretch the credibility for most readers but for this reader it merely made me hunger for more confirmation sources beyond website names. I would hope and expect that some of the 12 references would offer such confirmation.⁴ The amazing level of detail of some aspects (e.g., Ed Dames teaching a class on training young people for Mars expeditions, with Barack Obama auditing the class) do indeed call for some sort of evidence.⁵ Actually, for me, the book was so interesting that I was dismayed by the large number of typing and spelling errors that have the effect of reducing the credibility for the wrong reason. If the author would be willing to contact me, I would take the time and energy to tell him about such errors so that the readers of any second edition would not be distracted.⁶ Also, much of the material could be presented in a more chronologically consistent manner that would permit the readers to easily follow the timelines of who did what when. This reviewer thinks that skeptics need to be thinking about a central question posed by many of the claims: “If such events really happened, HOW have they been kept secret so successfully? THAT is what those in power don’t really want us to know. Why aren’t there more whistleblowers? Even if this book is only 50% accurate, the other 50% will drive your imagination wild. Read it.

Whether or not this book is true, it makes for fascinating reading. If it’s not true, it’s a thrilling science fiction novel. And if it really is true, well, it’s probably the greatest book ever written! I was amazed at the amount of information- both stories and science- that was presented! And I was also amazed at how specific the information was- especially the science. If it’s not true, the author surely has an incredible imagination. But, if it is true, I think it’s sad that such technology has been kept secret for so long- since the 1800’s! The benefit for humanity that could have already been achieved through full disclosure, well, it’s just sad that there are people out there who are greedy and powerful enough to suppress things just to make a buck. In any case, this is one book that will haunt my

thoughts forever. Especially the stuff about manipulating the Aether to create gravity, free energy and anti-gravity technologies. Possibly even teleportation! If nothing else, the material presented in this book is fun to think about!

I recommend this book highly. It provides an excellent overview of the interrelated UFO, anti-gravity and Secret Space Program fields from the 1890's to the 2000's without getting bogged down in the often repetitive details of many specific cases. As such, it should be of great interest to those already familiar with several aspects of the UFO phenomenon. It covers in a general way both the German and U.S. involvements with UFO technology starting in the early 20th century, through WWII and continuing into the post-war years. Considering that, in the 1920's, Robert Goddard's idea of using rocket propulsion to go to the Moon and planets was considered by most influential Americans to be utter madness, the U.S. had a lot of catching-up to do! While this book does not claim to contain any exclusive new material on the subjects it covers, it serves to present the reporting and findings of others in a systematic and unified fashion which is easy to read and follow. Admittedly, some of the revelations claimed recently by whistle-blower veterans of the Secret Space Program will require corroboration, since they include claims of age and time regression. In that respect, they differ from more classic reports of UFO activity that have often been witnessed by hundreds of people. Likewise, the related claims of inhabited bases on the surface of the Moon and Mars would inevitably raise the question of why these have not been reported by the numerous probes, orbiters and landers that have been sent to those bodies by several Earth nations over the last half century. None of these questions detract from this book's value. Buy it, read it, you won't be disappointed.

Of the dozens of books I have used for UFO and secret science research over the last several months this has to be the best! It covers lots of material and 90% of what I have read so far I can back up with other reliable sources. Much of it will sound like sci-fi to the uninitiated but anyone with a good background in the area will find this material very, very informative and interesting! Chapter 9 (Beyond Antigravity) I cannot speak for since time-travel and teleportation are not subjects I have researched yet so I am only speaking for the first 8 chapters at this time.

We are all aware of conspiracy theorists and crazy people with tinfoil hats. We are also aware of a genuine feeling deep within ourselves that something's in our country, in our government and on this earth do not make sense. Remember the "Space Race"? It seemed to just politelystop...fade

away. We all know better. We all know what we ourselves have seen and know. I highly recommend this book. Just a few pages in you'll know why. You may not know how you know, but believe me, you'll know!
