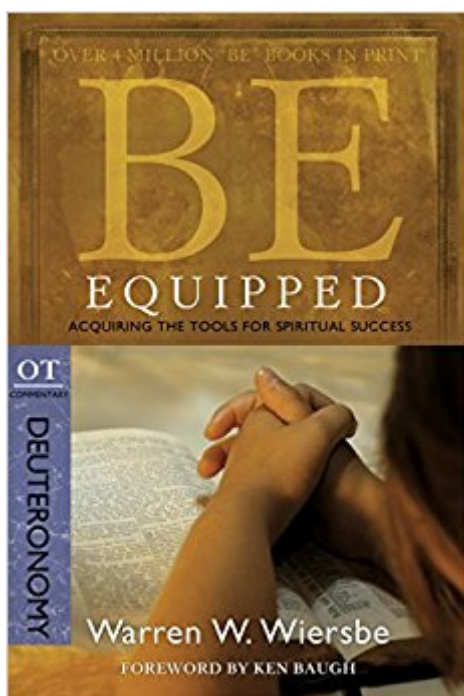

I have two commentary sets, one is Wiersbe and one is McGee (i am a lay person) I have used them for the last ten years and have found that they have given me a passion for the Word which fuels every other part of my life/ministry. I love that they both communicate in a way that is not too overly academic with sound doctrine. I use McGee's commentaries to pass out to people who have not established their quiet time (I find used/inexpensive hardback versions). I use Wiersbe's to supplement when I am studying one on one with an individual who already is using McGee's commentary. I have a degree in elementary education and you wouldn't believe how well this works with people (both those who have been Christians for a long time but not established a consistent quiet time and those who are not yet believers) These commentaries are amazing to help people retain information and keep them engaged in study. I do wish that Wiersbe's would follow verse by verse and put the scripture in the commentary (as many people including me, tend to be lazy and not follow well) as McGee's does as it is easier to follow, do study and reference but for whatever reason he summarizes by topic.
