

Lisa Westmoreland-Doherty grew up on a small farm in Shelby County, Kentucky, and attended the University of Louisville. Now she is a middle school teacher in Louisville and lives in Goshen with her husband, Jim, their two children, Jimmy and Sarah, and their two dogs, Mickey D. and Brinkley.

This book is a small, thin paperback intended to present cultural tourists with background information about Louisville's enormous stock of 19th-century architecture. It is arranged into six short tours, each featuring about five landmark structures. This book is nothing approaching an architectural survey of the city, but can be useful for finding sections of Louisville that will lead a curious traveler into self discovery. There are about 50 color photographs of important buildings in Louisville, but few are of high artistic quality. They are mostly functional. Recommended for casual browsing and cultural tourism.

Louisville Architectural Tours: 19th Century Gems is an eye-catching architectural tour of Louisville, Kentucky's historic districts, featuring full-color photographs on virtually every page. From the Conrad Caldwell House and the Pink Palace of Old Louisville, to the Gothic Revival-themed bed-and-breakfast at the Inn at Woodhaven, Louisville Architectural Tours features five tours that explore architectural history preserved.
