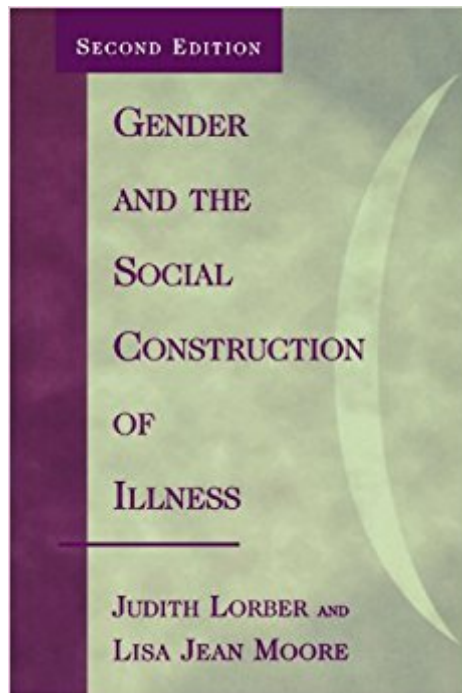

Disease OTOH is a long and chronic affliction, and Gender and the Social Construction of Illness is probably the only book that comprehensively shows how "gender race class ethnicity and culture influence the experience of the _symptoms_ of illness. This book also deals with the treatments within the current American health system succeeds or fails within those boundaries. Lorber gives extensive examples of Kleinman, & Sontag to highlight how people experience their illness based on a variety of external social and cultural factors. Recommended.
