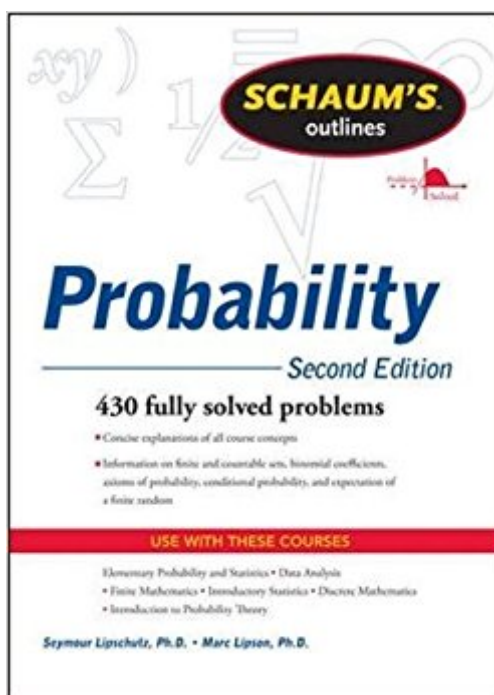

Author Profiles Seymour Lipschutz who is presently on the mathematics faculty of Temple University, formerly taught at the Polytechnic Institute of Brooklyn and was visiting professor in the Computer Science Department of Brooklyn College. He received his Ph.D. in 1960 at the Courant Institute of mathematical Sciences of New York University. Some of his other books in the Schaum's Outline Series are Beginning Linear Algebra; Discrete Mathematics, 3ed; and Linear Algebra, 4ed.

Marc Lipson is on the faculty of the University of Virginia. He formerly taught at the University of Georgia, Northeastern University, and Boston University. He received his Ph.D. in finance in 1994 from the University of Michigan. He is also coauthor of the Schaum's Outline of Discrete Mathematics, 3ed with Seymour Lipschutz.

Typos seem to be par for the course in math exercise books. I have yet to find a single one that doesn't have more than a typo per page. That gets extremely frustrating when the material gets harder. This one has about two or three typos per page if you're generous in your definition of "typo." Still, the material is well-rounded enough.

This is specifically regarding the kindle edition. Many expressions are partially provided as images and partially as text--this makes some of them rather difficult to decipher. This would be much better if such expressions were either typeset properly or presented entirely as images--having a bunch of text with a huge picture of a symbol in the middle apparently randomly placed in relation to the text doesn't do a thing for readability.

On page 5, figure 1-3 (a), the intersection of A and B should be also shaded. I don't know whether this is a printed mistake or the book has some errors. And I haven't been able to find the errata of this book. This book is good, however, I really need to see the errata!!!

The book has a lot of errors. Errors don't help when you are trying to learn a subject.
