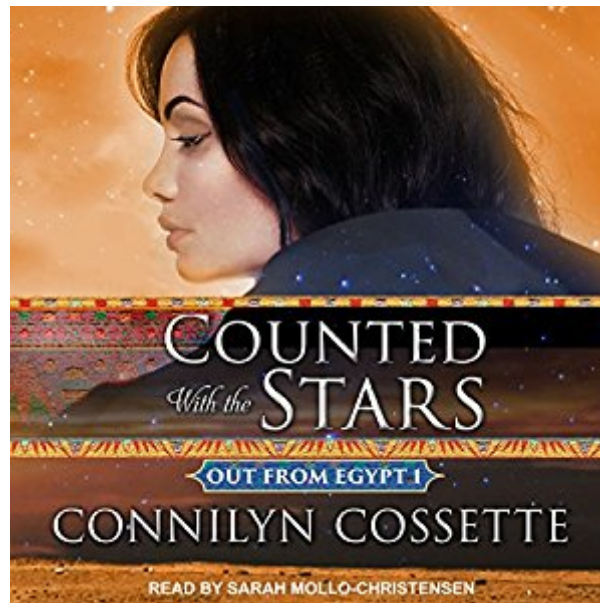


The book was found

It takes you to the place and time of being in Egypt before, and during the ten plagues, and the exodus of the Hebrews out of Egypt.
