

I bought this book prior to moving to Wyoming, so I could learn a little about my newly-adopted state. It gave me a good historical view, but not the current view. I'm not sorry I read it, because the history of the book, as it turns out, is part of Wyoming's history.

This book is smaller than I expected in height and breadth, but it's also thicker (as in, more pages) than I expected. It's not a new book by any means, using information that was commissioned

decades ago about Wyoming towns, but if you're writing something historical (like I am) that's more of a benefit than a problem. Quick delivery and good packaging.
