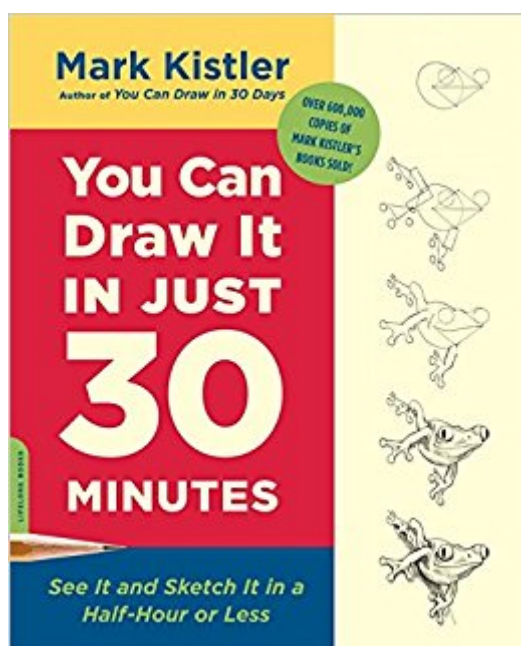

Mark Kistler is the author of nineteen books, including *You Can Draw in 30 Days*. He has worked as a classroom educator, a large audience presenter, an Emmy Award-winning television personality, a bestselling author/illustrator, a popular "virtual" instructor, and a respected drawing teacher for both adults and children. Each year, Mark Kistler travels to scores of schools around the country presenting his "Drawing in 3-D" assemblies and his evening Family Workshops to tens of thousands of adults and children.

I'm a self-taught artist that's never really found much use for the let's-draw-a-bunch-of-shapes

technique of sketching, but I actually found a lot of useful information in this book. The author's plan is for readers to begin at the first lesson and work their way straight through the book. Each lesson builds on itself, and I found some of the lessons on shading, adding in shadows, and capturing perspective extremely helpful. I've attached a few photos so you can see what I'm talking about. Kistler offers a great process for folks who would like to get their feet wet with drawing, so to speak. The author is very encouraging and has a fun easiness about him that makes sketching less intimidating. This book doesn't begin in the typical way with a list of tools that are needed. Instead, all you need to draw are this book, a pencil, and paper. Well done!

Mark Kistler's books are really fun! This one is great if you want to practice a little drawing project each day. I think it works well for adults and teens. It's written in a very appealing style and your drawings can look well if you follow the guidelines.
