

I sent this book to my brother, who is currently in jail for a drug problem. He read it and immediately felt God moving in his life. He took out his bible and began a regular bible study with the other inmates. This book opened his heart again. It's worth it. I wish I could send a copy to every inmate.

Max Lucado gives inspiration to hold on and be calm when times get rough and tough because God will use them for good. The story of Joseph who was abandoned by his brothers, who later sold him in slavery, Joseph who was imprisoned became the second most powerful man in Egypt and saved people from famine. Max Lucado also included verses for inspiration.

Max Lucado is a good author. Sometimes it's really tough to trust God when nothings going right. It

makes it easier if something good comes of it. Like the story of Joseph.

Less than 50 pages with large font and very large margins. Its a little feel good piece about going through tough times using Joseph's life as an example to persevere with positivity. Opinion: very superficial lacking depth. Too short to be used as any kind of study. Kind of similar to a homily compared to a sermon. I really like Max's books and own several. This book doesnt stackup to the others i have read. It was not what i was expecting.

Max Lucado is very good at distilling Biblical wisdom into real life situations. I found this book to be very short as his books have become lately. Some would say it's to the point. But when you're going through a difficult time, 'short and sweet' can feel clich $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\odot$ . This is a frequent subject of Christian writers and Max does it just as well as anyone. "Where is God when it Hurts" by Philip Yancey was a little meatier.
