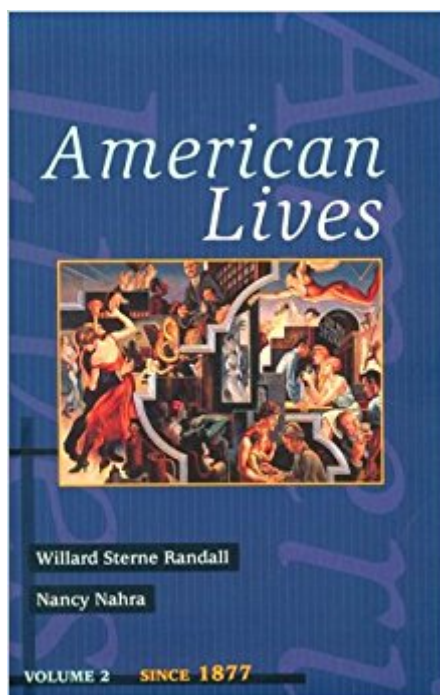

Each essay begins with a brief consideration of the historical context and concludes with provocative questions for thought and discussion and suggestions for further reading.
