

This is one of the worst illustrated hiking books I ever saw. The hikes and descriptions are actually good, but the illustration frustrating, confusing and annoying. Without continuous internet search it is impossible to know where the trails are located. It is a pitty for the good work of the author not having it published with a professional publisher (like "Rother Walking Guide"). The format of the

book is also way too big to bring it along on a hike. The publisher definitely is somebody who does not hike at all.

Pro: The things I like about this book is that it gives some detailed information about hikes such as elevation gain, length of trail, difficulty, etc., which is great.Con: The thing I didn't like is that there are a ton of trails near where I live and this book only gives a handful of some of the more "major" hikes that are the most well known. Unfortunately, while the books is a good supplement, I can get more comprehensive information/location from the Alaska dot org website. I would recommend the book if you are visiting Alaska and only have time for a few hikes - otherwise you can find more hikes/trail information on the AK website.
