

Jim Weiss has been a storyteller for more than twenty-five years. He lives and works in Charlottesville, Virginia.

There is a sound of the door opening and closing, followed by quiet. Then the crackling of a fire can be heard in the background as an elderly voice says: "I am Sir Bedivere, the last of the knights of the Round Table. Please sit down there by the fire, won't you . . . while I tell you about King Arthur." Then come the stories--as captivating as only Jim Weiss can tell them--of Excalibur, the Lady of the Lake, the adventures of Sir Percival and Sir Lancelot, the creation of the Round Table and more. No mention is made of the tragic love between Lancelot and Guinevere or the final battle and the death of Arthur. This is idealized storytelling, perfect as a charming introduction to Camelot and a celebration of storytelling magic. J.C. Be bold! Pass up the potato chip brain food that is Dora the Explorer and introduce your small children to history and science and art and math. You will be amazed and delighted by the pleasure they find in it when you make it regularly available to them.

My son started to listening to this CD when he was about 4 years old. Jim Weiss offers a fun retelling of the Arthur story in way that is engaging and entertaining for young listeners. He uses various sound effects and backgound noised to enhance the experience and encourage young imaginations to engage with the story. Although, a story on tape can never replace a parent reading this is a great tool to keep your kids entertained in the car or away from the TV if you need a little time to do the dishes. We listen to this at least once a week if not more. Great purchase.

My three and seven-year-old daughters beg to listen to this when we are in the car. The stories are rich, engaging, and promote positive values. My girls' creative play has been inspired in new directions by the King Arthur stories. They also have expressed strong interest in listening to the full length books of King Arthur stories read aloud to them, somthing I couldn't get them to sit still for before listening to the Jim Weiss recording. I highly recommend this recording.

Another good retelling from J. Weiss. My boys love it (9 and 7).

We are big fans of Jim's stories. This one is just as good a performance, but our girls (ages 6-10) aren't as excited about the story line as the Greek Myths and Sherlock Holmes.
