

These three animals are happy living their lives on the peaceful Bravelands. But when disaster strikes each young mammal, they must decide what path to take- the good, or the bad. Erin Hunter has done it again, with her fourth epic animal series. Truly a novel worth reading.

Suddenly a male lion comes and disrupts Fearless's life. He runs away and gets carried into a nest by an eagle. A baboon, Seed 'Stinger' Highleaf, saves him and Fearless gets a second chance at life with the Brightforest Troop. The second part is about a baboon named Thorn who tries to get higher up in the troop's social hierarchy to be with his true love, Berry Highleaf. To be able to be with her, Thorn has to steal an egg from a bird of prey, cross a crocodile infested river and defeat an opponent in battle. The last animal, Sky Strider is an orphaned elephant who takes care of her younger cousin, Moon. One day when visiting the bones of her mother, Sky

has a vision of danger. No one else believes her until the worst possible thing happens. These three unlikely heroes will have to figure out who is behind the murders of very important animals. When Thorn finds out the killer he is shocked and horrified. Fearless and he also have to rescue a lion cub in exchange for someone's life and succeed $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A}$ \hat{a} $\neg\tilde{A}$ $\hat{A}|$ with an exiting twist.
