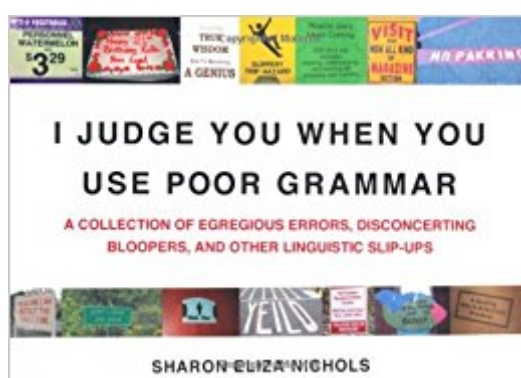

Sharon Eliza Nichols created the Facebook group *I Judge You When You Use Poor Grammar*, which boasts more than 350,000 members and 7,000 photos of misspelled and ungrammatical signs. Sharon has been featured in the *New York Times* and the *Wall Street Journal* and lives in Tuscaloosa, where she is a law student at the University of Alabama.

Most of the errors in here were not grammatical, which you would think might be important to the authors who did, after all, say this would be about poor grammar. It came off peevish and snippy rather than funny.

Repetitive types of signs: many misspellings, several misused quotation marks, apostrophes, etc. They weren't particularly amusing. The comments about each were not very clever - mostly just pointed out what was wrong in the signs (e.g., "the plural of 'knife' is knives"). May be good for later grade school kids for grammar and punctuation.

Get it? Actually, most of these photos are misspellings of "its" or "their/there/they're". Really repetitive. I'm sure there are better ones out there. Even the author's comments are tedious.

I thought this book would be a funny way to learn some common grammar mistakes but instead it is just the author bashing people that clearly don't speak english as their first language. Don't buy unless you really want to see a ton of photos with a miss use of commas and apostrophes.

A few "egregious" errors and many repeats of the same basic errors. Yes, I got the message about the use of an apostrophe. The book was mildly amusing for a few pages and then became repetitive and boring. When I bought this book I actually thought I might learn something of value. I did learn that I can still be misled by a title and throw my money away on drive.
